We are pleased to share that the Department of #Zoology, #ManipurInternationalUniversity has successfully achieved captive breeding of #PuntiusSophore (Phabou) for the first time in Manipur, under laboratory conditions using synthetic #hormones Ovasis. This success came after conducting several trials with optimized hormone dosages. One of the most remarkable outcomes of this #achievement is that #breeding was #successfully induced outside the normal breeding season, demonstrating the potential to #standardize this method for #sustainable seed #production throughout the year. This #breakthrough holds #significant #promise for the region, as it can greatly reduce the #dependence on #imported dried #Phabou used in the #traditional #Ngari #fermentation process. With further #refinement and large-scale #adoption, this #technique could become a major step toward #self-#sufficiency in Ngari production and support local fish farmers and #entrepreneurs in #Manipur.
